The ultimate governing body of the CPI is the CPI Council, comprising senior representatives from Member companies and from each of its supply-chain sectors.

CPI consults and supports its membership through standing

committees and sector bodies which are responsible to CPI Council. Standing committees deal with the many and varied issues facing the industry as well as the focused range of services provided to members.

Organisation and Management
